

Your School. Your Choice.

Open Enrollment is an opportunity to request that your student attend a school of choice, which is outside of their attendance area. Students who do not live within district boundaries, but want to attend a school in St. Vrain need to complete the Open Enrollment form.

December 3 - 17, 2018: Submit your open enrollment applications online

January 17, 2019: Deadline to receive approval or denial letter from school

February 1, 2019: Deadline to confirm your open enrollment spot at a school.

Open Enrollment Reminders

Students who are currently attending their school of choice on open enrollment do not need to reapply each year in order to remain at the same school.

Not all schools allow open enrollment. Each year the Board of Education reviews school populations, enrollment projections, building capacities and staff sizes and determines which schools can permit open enrollment.

Students whose applications are denied or whose applications were submitted after the December 17 deadline will be added to the waitlist of the requested school. Board policy also provides the opportunity of appeal.

- Receive an emailed confirmation of receipt.
- **Visit stvra.in/openenrollment to apply to any St. Vrain Valley public school.** (Charter schools have their own enrollment system, and there is a separate application process for special programs such as International Baccalaureate, STEM, PTECH, Leadership Academy, etc.)
- Open Enrollment will be available online December 3 at 6:00 a.m.
